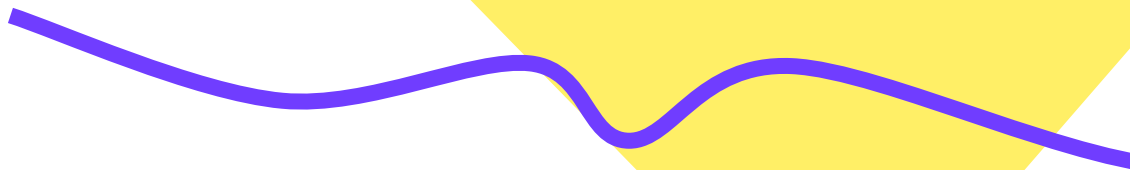




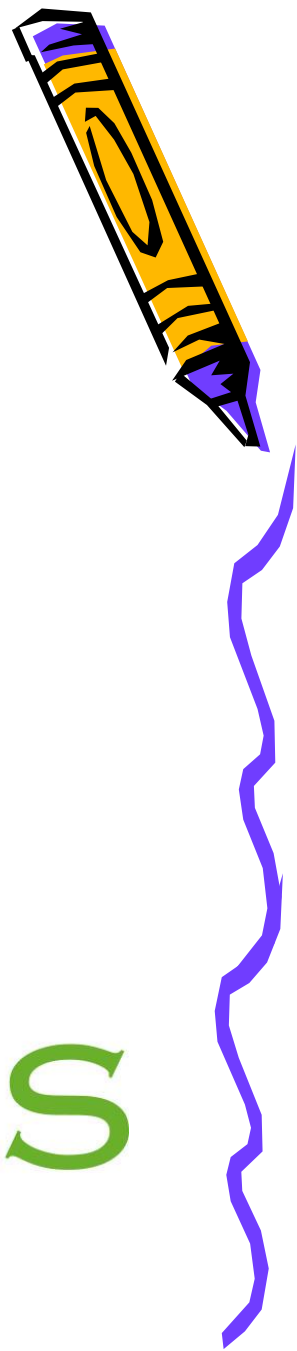

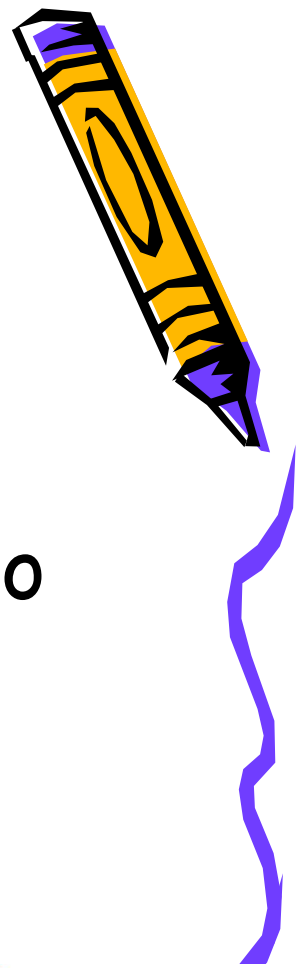

- - Science is a part of our everyday lives;



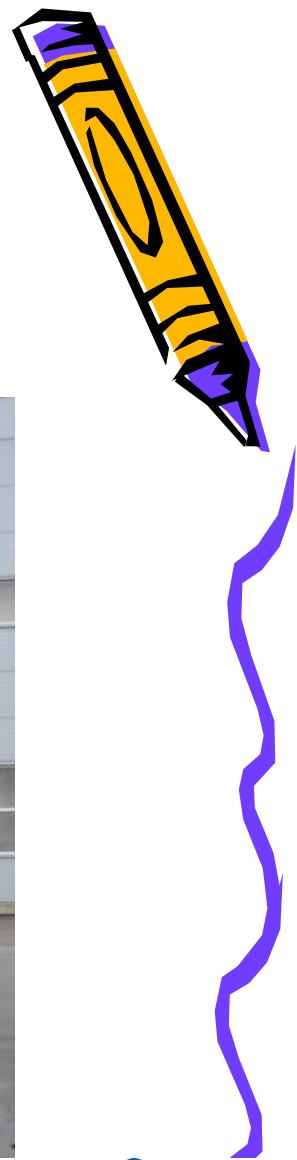

- We talked to many women in Science and all of them found their scientific jobs absolutely astonishing and exciting:



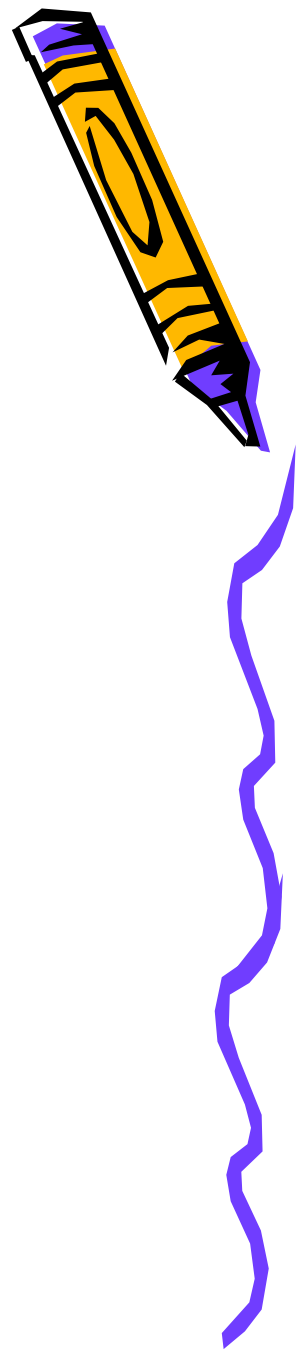

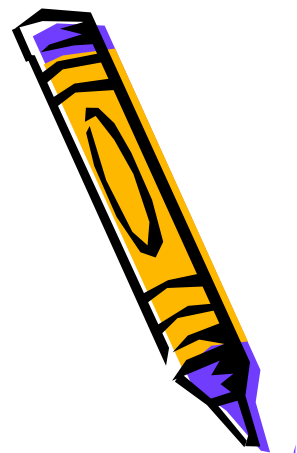
Science has invented a number of wonderful drugs that are used for pain killing and these drugs are very useful in everyday life.

X-Ray and body scanning machines are also very useful in daily life.



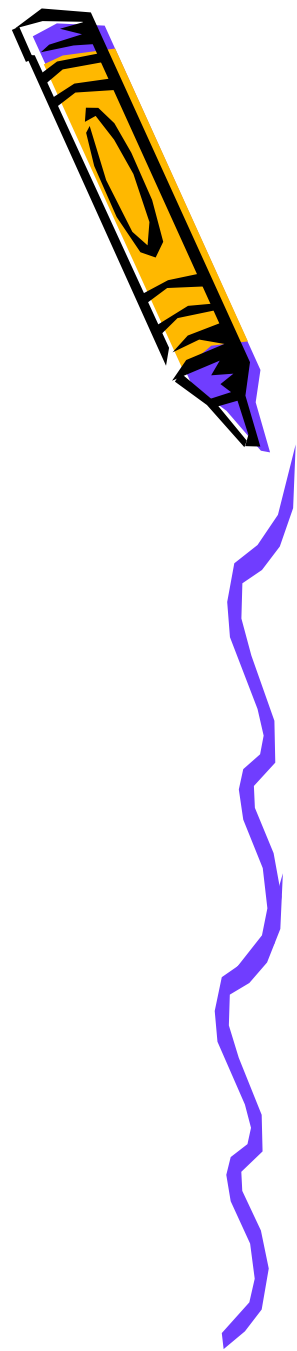

- Looking back at our activities we can admit that we have gained a lot of experience and knowledge. We are growing and changing and also want to change the world into the better.



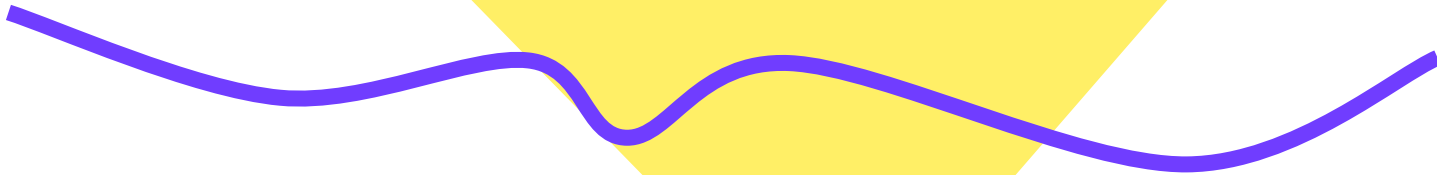
